6. CITIZENS ADVISORY COMMITTEE APPOINTMENT AND MEMBERSHIP GUIDELINES

General Manager Joe Guzzetta advised the CAC that the Board wants to establish formal guidelines for membership on the CAC, and has requested a recommendation from the CAC on guidelines and membership requirements that should be considered. It was noted that the Board Members present are here for the purpose of clarifying the Board's intent and answering questions that the CAC may have; and not to advise, guide, or direct the CAC on what recommendations to make.

The CAC discussed the matter extensively, considering options such as having the CAC appoint its own members; providing for broad stake-holder participation; the role of property owners, business representatives, and other groups; and whether or not the CAC should officially recommend candidates to the Board. Following discussion the CAC made the following recommendations:

- Reference to the CAC should be included in the Administrative Code since it is not currently referenced there
- Members of the CAC should be required to be voters of the Joshua Basin Water District

- Candidates should demonstrate an interest in water-related issues
- The District should accept a cover letter or bio, in lieu of a resume from candidates
- The application for membership should request the following if it is legal to do so:
